Students in grades 3-8 will be taking ISASP tests this week, April 15-19. This replaces the Iowa Assessment tests for these students.

ESA

The application window for ESA funds for the 2024 – 2025 school year is April 16 through June 30, 2024. If you desire to apply, all kindergarten students are eligible, regardless of income. Those who received ESA funds in the 2023-2024 school year will once again be eligible. This school year, households that are under 400% of poverty level – based on your Iowa tax return 1040: Line 4 (Iowa Taxable Income) are also eligible. More information and the application can be found at: <https://educate.iowa.gov/pk-12/educational-choice/education-savings-accounts> If your child/children received ESA funds in the 2023-2024 school year, you are still required to complete a new ESA application for the next year. **Applications received after the June 30 deadline will not be considered – please apply in a timely manner if you desire to do so.**
